

This Ministerial level event will provide an opportunity for HLF 4 participants to learn more about practical applications of innovative and potentially transformative results-based approaches, including results-based aid (RBA) and results-based financing (RBF).

Results-based approaches link funding to the achievement of results, reorienting incentives toward results and taking a new approach to conditionality. While their potential for putting results at the center of the development dialogue is promising, results-based approaches are a new and inadequately tested instrument. Some countries and organizations are beginning pilot programs and will share their experiences.
