

#### **Eco-labels as a tool for green growth?**

#### **Are Soft Regulatory Instruments effective?**

- Very little data
- Few evaluations
- Very little evidence
- Cost effectiveness is the key argument for the agreements.
- But a threat of regulation does not harm the motivation...



#### Can voluntary agreements work?

- SMART objectives are needed otherwise, how measure success?
- Objectives and indicators make monitoring possible
- And monitoring is necessary
- What if the agreement does not work?
