








# Economic growth

  - EUR 2.25 billion + EUR 1.3billion incentive scheme






# Strong regions and more efficient inter-regional transport


### Some examples:



# Road toll projects








National Transport Plan 2014–2023 An Expanding Market

## The NPRA contract portfolio (investments)

Annually about € 2 600 million (incl. toll funding)

Approximately 500 contracts, with the following dimensions:

 $\approx$  50 > € 6.6 million














## Maintenance

## Coastal Highway E39

- 1.100 km 7 ferry–connections
- Travel time 21 hours
- Ferry free within 20 years
- 7–8 hours reduced travel time
- Estimated investments 20.000 MEUR
- Activity mainly between the fjords during the first planning periode (4 years)


