1970-2013. Index 1970 = 100.



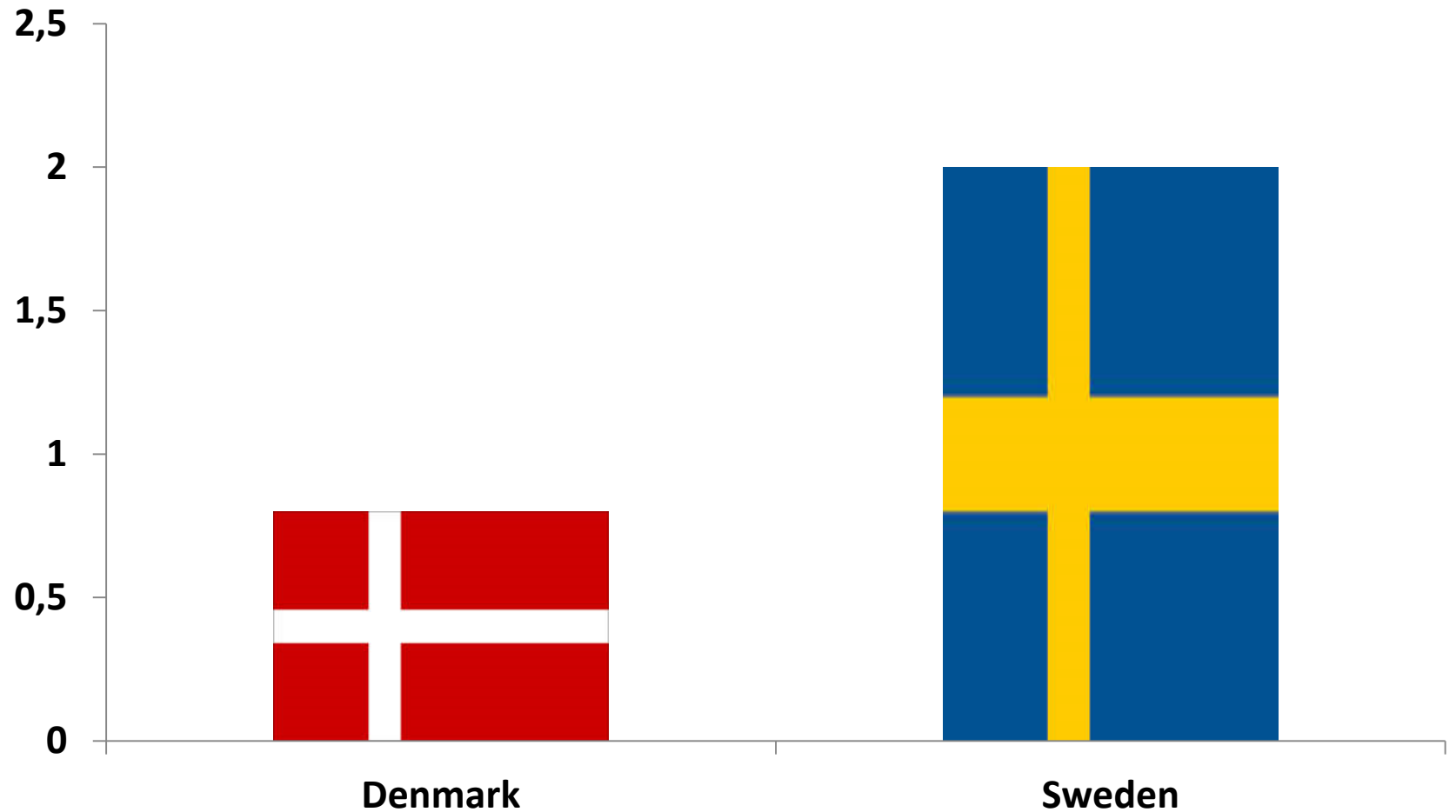

## Average annual productivity growth 1996-2011

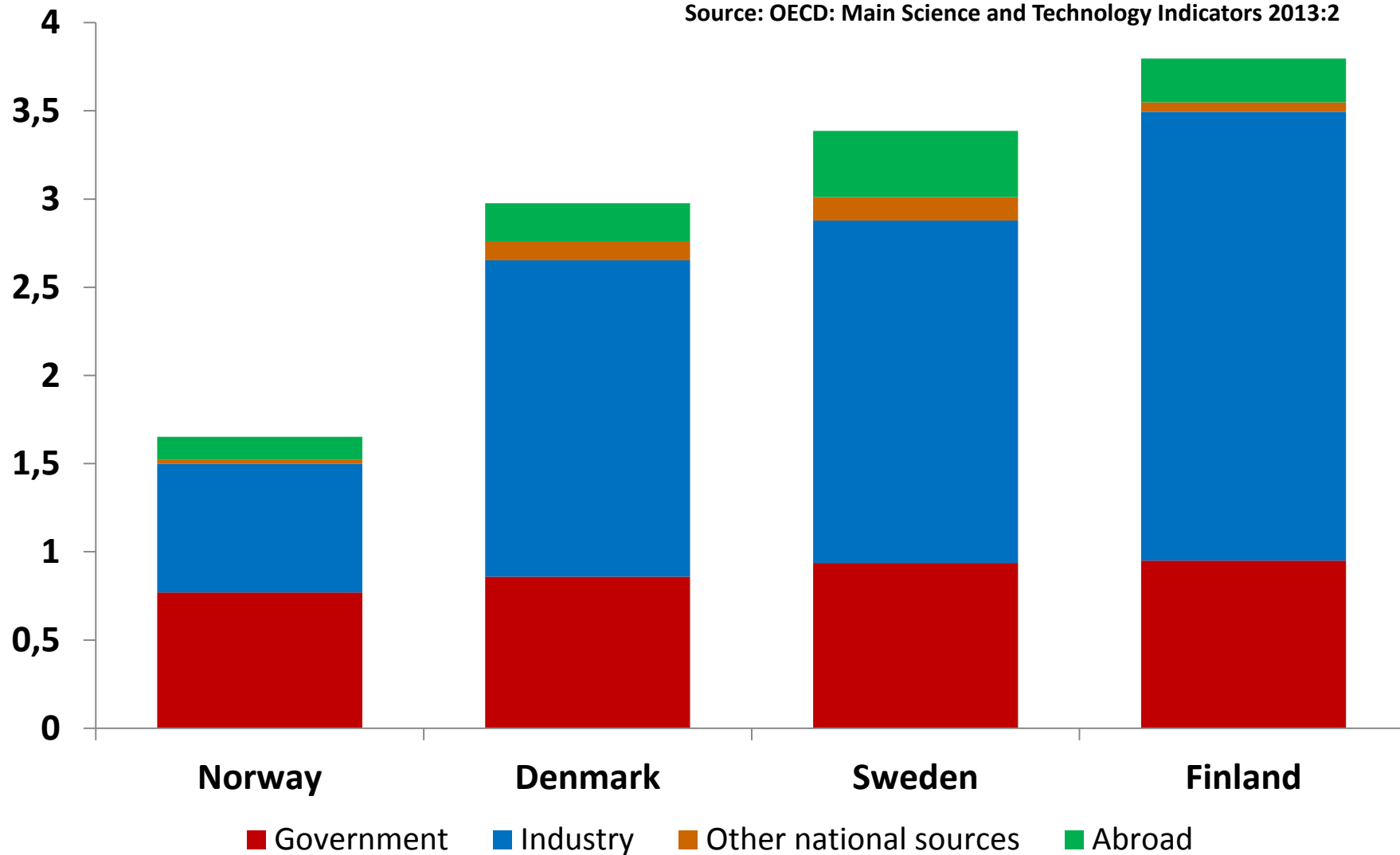
