Child Protection Measures on Meta's Platforms

As the Norwegian Minister of Children and Families, I refer to the recent settlement between Meta and multiple US states.

As part of the settlement, Meta has agreed to implement a number of measures across its platforms to better protect children and teenagers. I welcome such measures and expect Meta to take effective steps to safeguard all young users, including those in Norway.

At the same time, Norway is moving ahead with legislation establishing a minimum age of 16 for access to certain social media platforms. Under the proposed legislation, children will not be permitted to use these platforms until the year they turn 16.

I reiterate my firm expectation that Meta will implement effective, privacy-preserving ageverification solutions to ensure that children below the age limit cannot access its platforms.
