

Trade in Services Agreement (TISA)

Norway – First revised offer

Norway has revised its offer in track changes. Norway has revised its offer in certain areas in response to requests received by other TISA parties. There is also a small number of technical corrections. The main modifications in the revised offer are as follows:

- Streamlining of Section A to improve clarity and readability
- Deletion and narrowing of Section A reservations (technical testing and analysis, pipeline transportation, environmental services)
- Redrafting of the reservation on public utilities
- Refined reservation on new services and replaced reservation of "other services" by a small number of sector specific reservations
- Clarifying that the offer does not include water distribution
- Adjustments to some entries relating to the EEA Agreement
- Broader commitments for auditing and accounting services
- Adjusted real estate entry relating to local presence requirements not captured by NT
- Correction of entry on security services to reflect existing non-conforming measures
- Technical adjustments by aligning the commitments for financial services to the agreed model; scheduling of legal services according to the proposed model schedule, clarifying classification of education services, removed various insertions that were not NT restrictions, inserted legal citations for reservations subject to the ratchet
- Reinsertion of an MFN exemption that that was lost in formatting
