



The largest oil producers and exporters in 2005 (incl. NGL/condensate)



Total petroleum production




Macroeconomic indicators for the petroleum sector

The state organisation of petroleum operations





- Established in 1972
- The Government holds a 70.9% stake in Statoil
- Statoil operates according to the same terms and conditions as other commercial players on the NCS



- A 100 % government owned limited company
- Manages the SDFI assets on behalf of the Government
- A care-taker company not an oil company
- Relatively small company 60 employees



- Maintain a competitive Norwegian Continental Shelf
- Sustain a competitive petroleum industry based in Norway
