- 3rd largest exporter of natural gas in the world




Norwegian petroleum policy

- The petroleum deposits shall be administered for the benefit of the Norwegian society as a whole
- The right to petroleum deposits is vested in the State
- Goal: Maximize value creation




Statoil ASA

- Established in 1972 as a fully state-owned company
- Statoil was partially privatised in 2001
 - The state owns a 70.9 per cent stake of Statoil
 - The state will continue to be a substantial owner
- Today the government act as a professional owner in line with other shareholders




Norwegian Continental

resources









