With reference to Agreed Record of Conclusion of Fisheries Consultations on the Management of the Norwegian Spring-Spawning (Atlanto-Scandian) herring stock in the North-East Atlantic for 2007 between the European Community, the Faroe Icelands, Iceland, Norway and the Russian Federation of 18 January 2007, separate bilateral arrangements on access to the respective zones of fisheries jurisdiction of the Parties have been concluded.

The following arrangement between Norway and the Russian Federation will be applied:

Within the framework of the above five party arrangement the Russian Federation is granted access to fish 164,096 tonnes of herring in the Norwegian Economic Zone, the Fisheries Zone around Jan Mayen, and the Fisheries Protection Zone around Svalbard.
