We are pleased to deliver our final offer for a new election system to KRD and hope that we have used the dialogue phase well, so that we have succeeded in designing a solution that helps fulfill your targets for the e-voting project.

Reference projects

We have chosen to present 5 different reference projects with the purpose of showing our experience in different areas. These projects are described in more detail in the document "Reference projects.docx".

- Two of the projects show our experience in the e-voting field:
 - 310.000 French voters residing in Africa and America could cast votes over the Internet to elect their representatives to the Assembly of the French living abroad, which directly elects 12 senators to the French Senate.
 - The Austrian Ministry of Science and Technology selected Scytl's e-voting software to carry out the first binding Internet voting election in Austria. 240,000 students from 21 different universities cast their votes over the Internet in 376 simultaneous elections.
- Two projects show our experience in managing large development projects, one of them with extremely strong security requirements:
 - eResept Implementation of a nationwide system for electronic prescriptions and related applications, receipts, reports to the authorities etc. The system will be used by all physicians, hospitals, pharmacies, the Norwegian Medicines Agency and NAV.
 - Pocket GRS A PDA application for connecting the guards at duty and on call with Securitas Guard Reporting System. The guard receives information about a mission online to the PDA, and scan barcodes at the customer premises, showing that an inspection has taken place. Pilots are now running in Sweden, Germany and Norway.
- One project is a delivery of election services in order to conduct and support the 2009 parliament election. We contracted 430 municipalities on different election services and have chosen one of them, Bærum municipality as an example of a typical customer.

Customer feedback from the 2009 election

We have been delivering services for Norwegian elections for 20 years. What we are most proud of when it comes to our deliveries, is the customer satisfaction. Overall we get a high score on customer satisfaction from the municipalities. We think that it is because we try to prioritize support and information, even in difficult situations.

We haven't done the 2009 customer survey yet, so we have no results to show. Therefore we'd like to show a few feedbacks we have got from the municipalities after the 2009 election:

Prototype

The new prototype has undergone some changes compared to the last version. These changes are:

- In order to simplify accessibility, the user interface in the new prototype has been implemented completely in HTML.
- In order to improve usability, we have looked at the feedback you gave us on the former prototype and implemented several significant changes.
- We have focused on improving the perceived security of the prototype by introducing the new voting protocol, which adds:
 - o Zero trust in the client
 - Cast as intended proof
- Browser detection has been added to redirect voters to a specific page, showing which combinations of browsers and operating systems are supported.
