With reference to the Agreed Record of Conclusion of Fisheries Consultations on the Management of the Norwegian Spring-Spawning (Atlanto-Scandian) herring stock in the North-East Atlantic for 2008 between the Russian Federation, the European Community, the Faroe Islands, Iceland and Norway of 12 November 2008, separate bilateral arrangements on access to the respective zones of fisheries jurisdiction of the Parties have been concluded.

The following arrangement between the European Community and Norway will be applied:

Within the framework of the above five party arrangement the European Community is granted access to fish 88,939 tonnes of herring in areas under Norwegian fisheries jurisdiction north of 62°N.

Norway is granted access to fish 88,939 tonnes of herring in Community waters north of 62°N.

License arrangements are to be agreed upon at a later stage.
